**ANNUAL REPORT 2025-26**

On this meaningful occasion, I am glad to place before you a brief report of the academic activities of the college for the year 2025-26.

**THE MANAGEMENT:** Mulki Sunder Ram Shetty College was founded in 1980 with the objective of providing quality education to economically and socially disadvantaged students from rural areas. The College is managed by Vidyavardhaka Sangha (R.), Shirva which has been promoting the cause of educational development of this region for the past 81 years. The management is headed by Sri. Suresh P Shetty, Gurme, a renowned industrialist, entrepreneur and the Member of Legislative Assembly, Kaup constituency. He is ably assisted by Sri. V. Subbayya Hegde, the Correspondent, Prof. Y. Bhaskar Shetty, Administrative Officer and members of the executive committee in the implementation of our quality policy and plans.

**THE COLLEGE:** The College is affiliated to Mangalore University and is conferred permanent affiliation. The college is recognised by the U.G.C. and is recognised under 2(F) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council, New Delhi has re-accredited the college at A+ Grade with CGPA 3.36 in the fourth cycle of assessment during the year 2023.

**UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION RESULTS:** The quality of teaching-learning process of the college is reflected through the results in University examinations. We are pleased to place on record the academic results of our students which are consistently good and encouraging.

In the Mangalore University Examinations held in June/July 2025, the pass percentage of the outgoing batch was

In the final year B.Com, 29 students appeared for the exam out of which 10 students have secured distinction and 16 first class. In the Final year B.A, 14 students appeared for the exam out of which 07 students have secured distinction and 03 students first class. In the Final year BCA, 35 students appeared for the exam out of which 10 students have secured distinction and 15 students first class.

**LIBRARY:** The college has a separate library block with adequate learning resources consisting of 20,416 books worth Rs. 19, 75, 299.00, along with 4 dailies, 17 magazines and journals and computers with internet facility for staff and students. During the academic year, 67 books worth Rs. 12, 276.00 have been added. Each department has a department library for the benefit of staff and students. The library has 10 book banks established by leading nationalized banks of this region and charitable trusts. We are grateful to them for their generous support.
